What is a dental implant?

A dental implant is an artificial tooth root consisting of a titanium screw that resembles a tooth root. Missing teeth can be replaced with this high-tech technique and will look and function like real teeth. Dental implants can replace one or several missing teeth and offer a sound alternative to dentures and bridges.

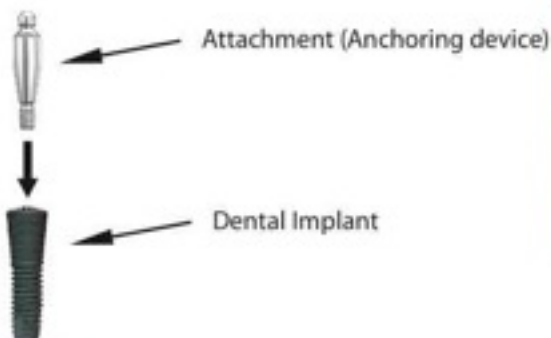
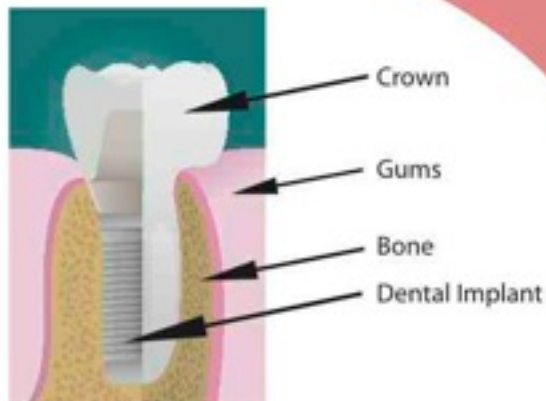
With each bite the dental implant stimulates the surrounding bone and preserves the integrity of the bone and prevents gum tissue shrinkage. After a tooth is lost the bone is not stimulated and begins to shrink away.

If you are missing all of your teeth in the upper or lower jaw, dental implants are the right solution.

Your prosthesis can be attached via anchoring devices to two or more dental implants. The prosthesis remains securely in place in your mouth - yet it is easy to remove.

Dental implants eliminate the discomfort and insecurity of loose, ill-fitting dentures.

Implant surgery is in most cases possible even if you take medications or your health may be compromised.



Treatment overview

1. Examination



Your prosthetist explains to you all relevant information about implant therapy. You will receive an exact **cost estimation**, so you will not experience any further cost later on. Once you have agreed you will be referred to AIDER.

At AIDER we **examine your jaws**. An x-ray assists our specialists to check the condition of the bone tissue and determine the placement of the dental implant.

2. Surgery



Two or more implants are placed using **minimal invasive procedures** in the jaw-bone.

The surgical procedure takes less than an hour and can be performed under a common local anaesthesia similar to one that is needed for a filling or an extraction. Pain and discomfort after the surgery are minimal.

3. Prosthetic



The implants need two months of healing. After the healing period we **install the attachments** on your implants that will be later on a secure foundation to attach the denture. This intervention takes just a few minutes.

Your prosthetist then **finishes your dentures** to perfection. The denture is fitted with corresponding devices underneath.

4. Maintenance

Like natural teeth dental implants need regular check-up and clean. If you attend regular check-ups we provide you a **life-time warranty** on your implants and its attachments.
